

How to assemble an up-swinging hinge

Step 1

Lay out the provided parts to up swinging hinge. Locate item 1 (tear drop plate) and attach to the top of the gate using item 2 (Long threaded gudgeon). Temporarily support gate against the post in the closed position at the required finished height using spacer blocks such as timber. Mark the top hole of item 1 onto your post and drill hole for fastening to post.

Step 2

Locate item 4 (Bottom tongue plate) and attach to the bottom of the gate using item 5 (Gate tongue bolt). Attach item 6 (short threaded gudgeon) onto item 4. Now attach item 7 (standard hinge post plate) to item 8 (bottom post base plate).

Step 3

Marry up item 6 (short threaded gudgeon) to item 7 (standard hinge post plate) this will allow you to mark the holes for item 8 (bottom post base plate) onto your post and drill the holes (recommend four holes) for fastening to the post.

Tip 1 pre assemble brackets and check the outside measurement and make sure they will fit between the post and the gate. So there will be no overlap on the gates.

Tip 2 EasyGate recommend to drill holes for bottom base plate 5mm higher to allow for sagging of plate.

Item:

1. Tear drop plate
2. Long threaded gudgeon
3. Nylon bush
4. Bottom gate tongue
5. Gate tongue bolt
6. Short threaded gudgeon.
7. Standard hinge post plate.
8. Bottom post base plate.
9. Standard hinge mounting bolts, washers and nuts.
