The teacher asked the children to start their programme. They were so the teacher new the third group was not present so the teacher gave the word. Most of children came to church without tithing so also encouraged to talk to their parents. Then we joined the elders and we started our service and we enjoyed our day.

CHURCH VISIT

During this month also visited at Zishamba. Here this is a new. There are new teachers. I gave them the syllabus and the programme. Here there are some children who wanted to be baptized since there was no water no more. Now the rainfall water is everywhere. We chose two teachers for our first time. Other refused to teach the children. So at first I started to teach the teachers and we teach the children we divided into two groups. Here they are more children at all ages.

CHURCH VISIT

At Dwaleni there are more children during the holidays. When schools open there are few children so more children learn at urban areas. So there are only two teachers. The first group is better than the other two groups so they learn together when schools are closed. I went in the villages to ask for who does not go to church. I got only two boys and three boys at Dwaleni church.

HOME VISIT

I visited at Mr B.Sibanda here there was only one boy. I asked for the boy and they accepted. I sang and prayed. After I preached the word on the book of Mathew chapter seven verse seven. They gave thanks because their son did not like to go to church. They left at home. We sang together and we prayed.

HOME VISIT

I visited at Mr Sibanda at village three in Mhondongori. Here there was a disabled boy. And his mother is also disabled. So I went asking for their details to be taken. I thank them because they don't abuse them. They tried by all means to fulfill their needs but because of shortage they don't get.

HOME VISIT

I also visited at Mrs Ncube homestead at Matebeleland. Here there was a crippled boy. He does not bath himself, does not work, you cannot ask him to help himself and she needed special school e.g for exercises and to learn to play with others. He does not talk mostly you use signs. So his granny has a big job because you cannot leave him alone. So here I also took his details. Then I sign the worshipping songs at pray and I dismissed.

DISTRICT MEETING

During this month I went at Makwasha church. It was a district meeting. We were eleven members. Our chairperson led the meeting. We give thanks to all who did well their graduation and parties. He also encouraged the volunteers to invite each other. We should build shades for the children to be protected.

We thank Msipani, Mab hazuli and Sibozza arranging their service every Sunday. We also planned about our workshops and it is now one day not three days. Every circuit must pay \$10 for food.

BIG SUNDAY

During this month I went at Mtishanda Church. It was a big Sunday and there were many children even others were absent because of rainfall. There about forty three children. And there we are five teachers. We first have our service and we join the majority. And I also encouraged teachers children will have enough time to read, preach and sing.

CHALLENGES

During this month I faced most challenges of rainfall. And church has no building. And also distance where there is building it is shortage of transport. Other children refuse to travel the long distance.

MISSION

My mission is to have more building in our circuit or even to build some shade even for sun. Also to be supported when we request the needful. To have strong teachers who work or support the ministry. To be strong and humanity.
