DELIVERIES

As usual in December we distributed some groceries to each one of our children. In addition to these food stuffs, we gave each child a Christmas food hamper. All the items were received with joy and thankfulness by children and their guardians. With these our children had a good and enjoyable Christmas despite the harsh economic situation we are in.



SEED

In our quest to training children to work and produce their own food, during this period we bought and distributed maize seed and gave it to those in the rural areas who have land. Much of the seed was planted on time and we had hope of having a good harvest but unfortunately we did not receive enough rains again this year. A few of our children will harvest something but the majority have nothing in their fields.

2023 GRADE SEVEN RESULTS

In January this year we celebrated the announcements of grade seven results and we are happy that out of 22 children in TIGO who wrote these grade seven examinations, Half of them did well. Our best student was Collet Baloyi who scored 8 points. So far they are now enrolled into form one.

2023 ORDINARY LEVEL RESULTS

Ten students sat for these examination and 4 passed. These are Mcebisi Dube who passed 6 subjects and he intends going to polytechnic college, Sibongile Nyoni passed with 5 subjects and is going into A level, Sifiso Mujuluka passed with 6 subjects and is advancing to A level, Norma Dube passed with 4 subjects and is studying to sit for 2 more subjects in June this year.

SAFE HOUSE

We have two new children at the safe house to make the number 4. The TIGO committee saw it necessary to bring these two in the safe house for their good.



CONCLUSION

The TIGO committee is so much geared to press on with the work as we try to help these children to have a bright future ahead. The current total number of children who remain in the program is 148 and out of those, 145 attend school and there are 3 preschoolers.
