 - As the pastor in charge of prayer department we did have our district allnight on the 4th of January as a district of magless church.

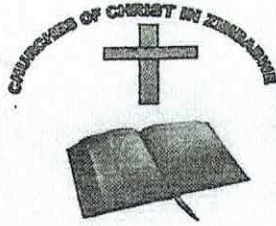
SECTION 7. CONCLUSION:
