Does my forklift need a WOF?

- Do you drive it on the road, in a car park or in your yard where the public have access to? - Yes
- Is it used only on your own premises within an area restricted with no public access, ie controlled by a gate house or inside a warehouse? No

What are the costs?

- Initial registration (must be registered with LTSA) plates and 1 year registration \$190,
 then
- Annual registration of a forklift approx \$57*
- Onsite WOF Inspection/Safe Forklift Compliance \$190 per check.

*one annual check for new forklifts, 2 x 6 monthly checks for forklifts 6 years and older.

Why does a forklift WOF cost more than a car?

- This is a specialist forklift WOF, our technicians are required to prove 5 years of experience on forklifts before being issued an Inspectors Certificate.
