Nelson Rowing Club (NRC) is committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children in its care. We recognise the responsibility to promote safe practices and to protect all children from harm, abuse and exploitation while participating in our activities.

For the purpose of this policy and associated procedures a child is recognised as someone under the age of 18 years.

Policy Objectives:

The aim of this policy is to promote good practice through:

- Promoting the health and welfare of children by providing opportunities for them to take part in rowing activities safely.
- Implementing appropriate procedures to safeguard the well-being of children and protect them from abuse.
- Requiring coaches, members and volunteers to abide by the Child Protection Policy and procedures.
- Responding to any allegation of misconduct or abuse of children in line with the Policy and procedures as well as implementing, where appropriate, disciplinary action at the discretion of the Nelson Rowing Club committee.
- Regularly monitoring and evaluating the implementation of this Policy and procedures.
