Recently there has been some publicity about the criminal actions of a few people, some being youths. Their poor behaviours and decision making have brought about concern for customers, policing and organisations such as the New Lynn Business Association. To that point, we take safety, security and wellbeing of the community seriously. The New Lynn Business Association has recently installed five CCTV's in the town centre, we are mindful that there is a significant responsibility of community safety that is in the hands of local and central

government agencies such as policing and Auckland Council. However, we as an organisation are also taking measures to improve safety in the area – the funds to pay for the CCTV project come from the members of the NLBA. The NLBA has also made a recent small donation to Community Patrols. We thank the community patrols team for all the good work they do. We acknowledge the policing team have made some arrests and have put measures in place to try to mitigate security matters, and, we are pleased to see more frontline police in the New Lynn area and a focus of safety on the Transport Hub – a responsibility of Council. The policing team have made a statement regarding the recent anti-social transport hub behaviour and we share this with you in this newsletter.

Police Update

Over the past month Police has received a spike of calls to service and reports of disorders and assaults in predominantly the New Lynn and Henderson areas mainly occurring at the transport hubs.

Police have responded to this with an increased patrolling presence over the past two weeks with a focus on engaging with and disrupting young people congregating in the area due to the majority of incidents involving this demographic.

Waitakere Police have also been working behind the scenes engaging with various local partners and today are commencing Operation Haumarū (safe place) over the next two weeks.

During this time community Police staff have been rostered to work during the hours of late afternoon and evening between 3:00 and 8:00pm and will be actively patrolling the affected areas on foot.

Due to the spike in crime in New Lynn this is where our main focus will be for the first week before moving to Henderson starting Monday 27th May.

They will be supported by staff and volunteers from Auckland Transport, One Rail, Community Patrol New Zealand, Tamaki Makarau Safety Patrollers, Waipareira Trust, Pacific Wardens and other community engagement groups.

We encourage all members to remain vigilant and report any matters to Police either via 111 if it is happening at the time or 105 if the incident is historic.

Safety is the priority and first consideration with any information that can be obtained.

Details on time and place, descriptions of any persons of interest and a summary of what

has occurred.

Please do not attempt to intervene or interrupt reportable behavior. This puts you at direct risk to unknown threats.

Filming or photography, if noticed by offenders can also elicit a dangerous response, please exercise caution.

Staff have been instructed to engage with all people during their patrols including businesses expect Police visiting and talking to you and your staff.
