Les Mills New Lynn Marks 25 Years in the West Auckland Community

For 25 years, Les Mills New Lynn has been part of the fabric of West Auckland, a place where locals show up, train hard, and build something together that goes well beyond fitness.

The club opened its doors on 2 July 2001, taking over the space that had previously been home to Don Oliver's.

Two and a half decades on, it's almost unrecognisable inside.

Over the years, the club has grown alongside the community it serves. Ongoing renovations have reshaped the space, including two new group fitness studios and a dedicated women's only training area. The timetable now runs hundreds of group fitness classes a week, and the club has introduced the latest Les Mills offerings, including CEREMONY®. What's stayed constant through all of it is the people: the members who've trained here for years, and the instructors and staff who've made the club feel like a second home.

Few people know that better than

Club Manager Jaci Griffin, who has been part of Les Mills New Lynn since the day it opened.

"I've watched this club grow for 25 years, and what makes me proudest isn't the new studios or the classes, it's the people. Generations of West Aucklanders have walked through these doors, and so many of them have become part of the family. That's what keeps me here."

To mark the milestone, the club is hosting a celebration across July, with a 25-year photo wall, refreshments, throwback classes, and recognition of the staff and instructors who've shaped the club over the years.

The celebration runs into an open weekend on 24 to 26 July, when anyone is welcome to come along, experience the community, and see what 25 years at Les Mills New Lynn is all about.

Founded on the dream of Olympic athlete Les Mills Senior, the Les Mills fitness brand has become internationally successful, while still proudly New Zealand owned and operated. Since opening the first club at Victoria Street in Auckland City in 1968, Les Mills has been dedicated to their purpose of 'making humans fit for life'. Now, nearly 60 years later, they have grown to 12 clubs nationwide and several generations of New Zealanders have experienced the mental and physical benefits of the Les Mills offering. Sadly, Les Mills passed away peacefully on 29 June, aged 91.

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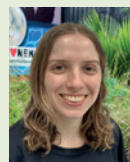
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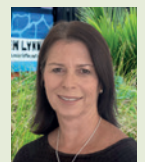
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
