SME Assistance

The government has announced a low interest loan scheme for small and medium businesses. Businesses will be able to borrow from the government for up to five years, at 3% interest. No repayments will be required for the two years. If a firm/business can repay the loan within one year, then it will be interest free.

The amount each business can borrow is a base amount of \$10,000, plus and extra \$1,800 per full time equivalent employee. So for example, a firm with five employees would be able to borrow \$19,000, made up of the base of \$10,000 plus another \$9,000 based on their employee numbers. The maximum amount that can be borrowed is \$100,000.

The loan is to cover fixed costs that firms have had to continue paying during the lockdown, such as rents, rates and insurance.

The loan will be made available through the Inland Revenue Department. Businesses will have to declare that they are a viable business, and that they will use the money for core operating expenses. They will also have to enter into a legally binding loan contract.

The scheme will open on 12 May, and Inland Revenue will aim to get the money to businesses as soon as possible, to help with cashflow.

Budget Review

The NLBA executive are mindful of the need to review the budget as we move into the next 6 -12 months of trading on how we would operate and what we could do to respond to the pandemic situation. There has been a review of the budget lines and a revision of the budget line which has had a 4.5% reduction in the 2020-2021 annual budget. One of the projects in the new budget is a specific shop local campaign and another being a campaign post COVID-19 – our future and recovery.


