NLBA / Auckland Council asset improvement survey work update

Recently, the NLBA submitted the results of a survey that was completed by NLBA and sponsored by Auckland Council on minor asset improvements. The public and members were surveyed and asked their views about minor assets in the New Lynn town centre. We were seeking their opinion on asset improvements (lighting, planting, green spaces, waste, seating, signs, footpaths and other small projects). Results of the survey have been submitted to Auckland Council and they are in talks with the Whau Local Board as to an allocation of funding for future projects, we will keep you informed on progress and, next month we hope to share further details depending on the timing and decision process.


