When the culvert collapsed our business slowed down, but once repaired and finished we are very busy, and service all motor scooters and quad bikes in our workshop. New Lynn has been great for us; we are the only sales and servicing for motor scooters in West Auckland. We meet once a month with the New Lynn Business Association and find they are very helpful with promoting New Lynn. Due to our over 50 years in business we stock a very large range of motor accessories that are hard to get and import parts that can't be sourced in New Zealand. We are LMVD dealers and MAF approved.
