Businesses such as restaurants, cafés, bars, fast food outlets, takeaways, lunch bars and bakeries.

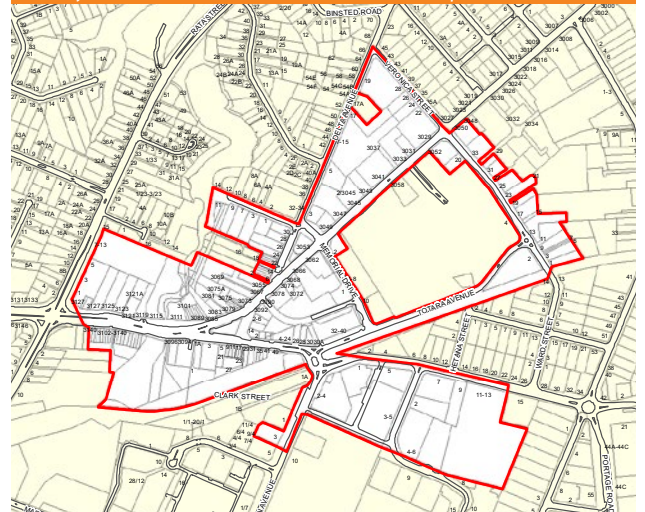


All category winners are eligible for the Supreme award.

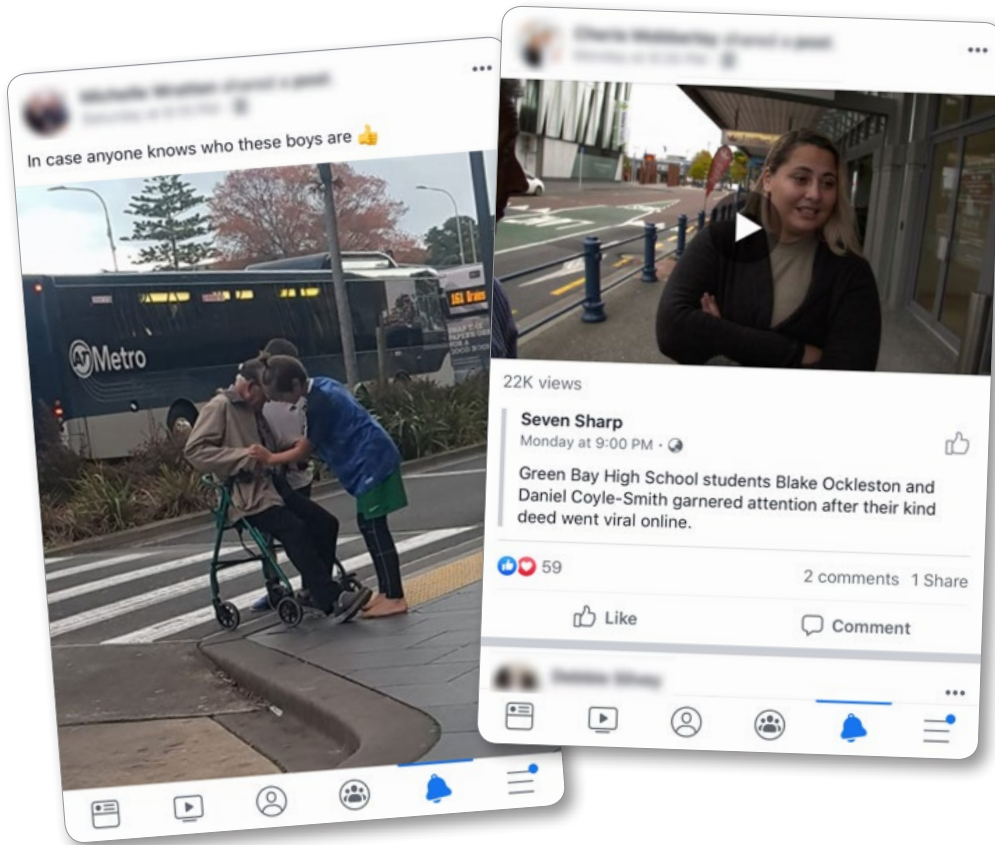

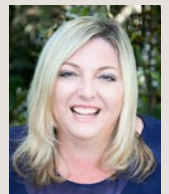
