New Lynn is unlike many other major mixed-use development areas in the wider Auckland region in that it is a prime city fringe location with a well established town centre, a sophisticated public transport network and has had recent substantial investment in infrastructure, commercial and residential spaces. In the past few years we have seen substantial development

in the town centre. LynnMall has started their shopping centre development with a proposed completion date of late 2015, the transit centre continues to attract public transport users, the new apartment building is full and other commercial and residential projects have started.

With this in mind, we have heard that Clinker Place has sold, this is a significant piece of mixed use land which offers development opportunities. The land is 5.68ha and is ready for development; a site that hosted Monier and Crown Lynn is a local landmark. The area is planned for shops, hospitality, entertainment and residential development. It's a great location and has a significant opportunity to enhance the town centre. With the neighbouring green space in Crown Lynn Park, there is real potential for a live, work and play environment in New Lynn. When we hear more about this development our team will share communications.

In thinking through the high growth of population and expansion of Auckland, our committee are reminded about how change rapidly occurs. 
