BUSINESS ASSOCIATION NEWS

Another month has passed us by and it feels like time is flying by. Perhaps that is because the executive and management of the NLBA have been busy working through a number of New Lynn projects, with the main one being the portfolio of safety and crime in New Lynn.

The New Lynn Business Association executive management are pleased to share with you that the many hours of work on bringing about change on the matter of safety in New Lynn has gained traction. The first action was in February, when the NLBA's GM Tracy had brought together some businesses that experienced issues with crime. This team that met consisted of Shirley from Mix Moon, Enosh from McDonalds (on behalf of Dinesh), Derek Battersby and Tracy. Since then there have been papers presented to the Whau Local Board for support, Police meetings, attendance at the local board's Safety Portfolio meeting, attendance at a formal meeting of the Whau Local Board with Tracy presenting a deposition, a public meeting of the Ambrico residents, a public Safety Summit held by MP David Cunliffe and many other meetings to garner support. The result is that the Whau Local Board have granted \$10,000 to the NLBA for additional CCTV's, with an application to be presented to the TTCFL for the shortfall of \$10,000. The Auckland Council team are working on a number of projects including a CPTED report proposal and safety and crime prevention plans. We also organised a series of Conflict Resolution Trainings, free of charge for NLBA business people and their staff with over 50 people taking up this offer (photos of one training session are in the newsletter). As we are progressing in this work, we would like to take this opportunity to thank the New Lynn Policing team and the many other stakeholders who have been working alongside us to make improvements. As the

matter of safety and security is the responsibility of so many, we are working collaboratively to ensure the best for our general and business community.

Other activities that we have been involved in are the general promotions in the town centre, which includes the BNZ and NLBA 'Dress Your Piggy' competition for business people. Thanks to those who have entered! Some of the competition entry photos are in this newsletter. The winners will be announced the week of the 9th May 2016. Thank you to the BNZ team for supporting this activity.

The strategy for the next three years for the NLBA has been completed and approved by the executive, which has also been presented to Auckland Council via the Whau Local Board alongside the budgets and audited accounts. If you would like to know more, please contact us.




MOTHER'S DAY PROMOTION
