REPRESENTATIVE PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the Nelson Pool Association Representative Team, you are required to abide by the following rules.

1. Players/Officials shall wear their uniform (where Supplied) for the duration of all games and including prizegiving Ceremonies.
2. Players /Officials shall conduct themselves in a responsible, friendly and supportive manner at all times.
3. Players / Officials shall not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs whilst playing or officiating.
4. Players / Officials are requested to support other members of the team playing and that leave of absence shall not be granted to play pokies, go shopping, get lotto etc. However, applications may be made to Captain prior to play commencing for personal reasons that may require the player to be absent for a set time.
5. Players are required to abide by any reasonable request made by their team Captain, elected Selectors or officer of the Nelson Pool Association leading up to and during games and prizegiving ceremonies.
6. Players are requested to attend a reasonable number of practices during the year. If unable to attend, then players are required to contact their team Captain or member of the Rep Committee prior to the practice session.
7. Players are required to be available for all Representative fixtures. Any player who fails to appear at a fixture without prior notice may face disciplinary action. Any player unable to attend a fixture must inform their team Captain or Rep Facilitator at the earliest convenience. Withdrawals notified less than 14 days' notice may attract disciplinary action.
8. Players who fail to abide by the Code or act in a manner deemed to violate the Code, or the Nelson Pool Association rules, shall face disciplinary action.
9. Disciplinary matters shall, in the first instance, be dealt with by the Rep Committee. The Committee has the right to suspend, expel or demote a player from the Rep Squad, or take any other action as they deem appropriate. Any player wishing to appeal a decision/ ruling of the Rep Committee must do so within 14 days of the decision/ ruling. The Executive Committee may hear the appeal at an open meeting, or have the right to uphold the decision of the Rep Committee, or make changes to the ruling as they deem appropriate. The decision of the Executive Committee shall be final.
10. Rep Squad Players including reserves, will be decided by the Elected Selectors
