



Strengthening our Community Sector

Development Programme for Nelson/Tasman Not-for-Profits

The Nelson Tasman Business Trust is running a capability development programme in partnership with Rātā Foundation in the 20/21 year for a group of six to ten Not-for-Profit organisations in our region. The programme is intended to support an effective sustainable and thriving community sector.

The Programme

- ✓ A one to one consultation and organisational assessment for each Not-for-Profit
- ✓ 12 months of individual tailored mentoring with a Business Mentor *at a cost to the Not-for-Profit of \$295 + GST*
- ✓ A series of practical development workshops based on capability development requirements and/or areas of intended focus. For example, Financial Literacy, People & Capability, and other topics with an operational focus.
- ✓ Regular open networking and training opportunities through the Business Trust.

Outcomes

- Greater organisational resilience and sustainability
- Enhanced ability to deliver on organisational mission and strategy
- Peer to peer learning, and collaboration on shared challenges leading to on-going efficiencies and innovation.

Programme Value

This unique 12-month programme offering by the Trust will deliver experienced business advisory support and capability development targeted at the specific needs of the programme participants, as well as common challenges in the local non-profit sector.

It is intended that the programme:

- Develop the management and operational effectiveness of the non-profit, enhancing resilience in the current economic landscape.
- Be a tailored learning opportunity that facilitates connection, collaboration, and peer support for the community sector.

- Help to underpin a strong and vibrant non-profit sector in our region, impacting directly and positively on the wellbeing of the people and whānau that make up our community.

A tailored 12-month programme of this nature in the business sector would likely cost upwards of \$3000 and is being provided at just \$295 +gst.
