In establishing these plantations, Quintis has created a reliable and ethical supply of Indian sandalwood logs, oil, chips and powder for decades to come. However, Quintis' sandalwood expertise does not stop there. Quintis also supplies sustainably harvested Australian sandalwood (*Santalum spicatum*) oil, steam distilled at our custom-built distillation facility.
