Driver Licence funding announcement

01 July 2022.

Budget 2022 has included funding to help more New Zealanders get their driver licence. The funding will be phased over four years.

In the first year of funding, starting in July 2022, we'll focus on rolling over existing contracts that are delivering great outcomes for New Zealanders.

We'll also start consultation and engagement with providers, agencies and people who need driver licence support. This is to inform the design of new contracting frameworks and referral pathways.

We plan to have changes fully in place by 2025 which will enable ongoing support for around 20,000 people each year.
