



## ABOUT THE MOVIES

**Crime 101 (M) Crime/Drama 2hr20m** An elusive thief, encounters a disillusioned insurance broker at her own crossroads. As their paths intertwine, a relentless detective trails them hoping to thwart the multi-million dollar heist they are planning.

**EPIC: Elvis Presley in Concert (PG) Documentary/Music 1hr40m** Featuring long-lost footage from Presley's legendary Las Vegas residency in the 1970s, woven together with rare 16mm footage from Elvis on Tour & precious 8mm from the Graceland archive.

**Goat (PG) Kids/Animals/Adventure/Sport 1hr40m** A small goat with big dreams gets a once-in-a-lifetime shot to join the pros and play roball, a high-intensity, co-ed, full-contact sport dominated by the fastest, fiercest animals in the world.

**Holy Days (PG) Comedy/Drama 1hr40m** Screen legends Miriam Margolyes, Jacki Weaver & Judy Davis are three old nuns on a mission in this road trip heart warmer set in 1970s NZ, joined by a lost boy searching for heaven & a car powered by God (& stolen money).

**LOTR: The Fellowship of the Rings (Extended Version) Action Epic Adventure (M) 3hr40min (plus 10 min intro from Peter Jackson)** An ancient Ring lost for centuries has been found & has been given to a small Hobbit named Frodo. When Gandalf discovers the Ring is the One Ring of the Dark Lord Sauron, Frodo must make a quest to Mount Doom to destroy it.

**LOTR: The Two Towers (Extended Version) Action Epic Adventure (M) 3hr45min (plus 7 min intro from Peter Jackson)** The continuing quest of Frodo & the Fellowship to destroy the One Ring. They discover they are being followed by the mysterious Gollum. Aragorn, the Elf archer Legolas & Gimli the Dwarf encounter the besieged Rohan kingdom.

**LOTR: The Return of the King (Extended Version) Action Epic Adventure (M) 4hr20m (plus 13 min intro from Peter Jackson)** The final confrontation between the forces of good & evil fighting for control of the future of Middle earth. Frodo & Sam reach Mordor in their quest to destroy the One Ring.

**Midwinter Break (M) Drama 1hr30m** Stella & Gerry, a long-time married couple, reach a crossroads in their relationship when they take a trip to Amsterdam that stirs up memories of the past. The film is based on the 2017 novel of the same name.

**No Other Choice (M) Dark Comedy/Thriller 2hr20m (subtitles)** Lee Byung-hun leads this darkly comedic crime thriller about a man who, after being unemployed for several years, devises a unique plan to secure a new job: eliminate his competition.

**Nouvelle Vague (M) Biography/History/Drama 1hr45m (subtitles)** The behind the scenes of the filming of Jean-Luc Godard's Breathless (1960), a landmark of the French New Wave film movement.

**Sirat (M) Drama/Music 2hr (subtitles)** A father and his son arrive at a rave deep in the mountains of southern Morocco, searching for their daughter and sister in the unfamiliar world of dance music culture.

**Straykids: The dominATE Experience (PG) Recorded Live Performance 2hr30m** Features the live performance of Stray Kids' sold-out Sofi Stadium shows in late May, as well as behind the scenes footage that lets fans into the hidden world of one of the biggest and most popular K-Pop groups on the planet.

**Tenor: My Name is Pati (PG) Documentary/Music/True Story 1hr40mins** The story of Pene Pati & his brother Amitai Pati & their against-the-odds journey from Samoa to platinum-selling success in the trio Sol3 Mio and on to the world's greatest opera stages.

**The Testament of Ann Lee (M) Period Drama/Musical 2hr20m** Ann Lee, the founding leader of the Shaker Movement, proclaimed as the female Christ by her followers. Depicts her establishment of a utopian society and the Shakers' worship through song and dance, based on real events.

**Toitu Visual Sovereignty (E) Documentary 1hr40m** Showcasing the largest Contemporary Māori Art exhibition at the Auckland Art Gallery. It follows the journey of curator Nigel Borell as he navigates the constraints between institutional authority & Māori self-determination.

**Wildboy (E) Documentary/Sport 1hr40m** Brando an 18yr old young man with ADHD, embarks on extraordinary adventures to escape society & find purpose. He sets out to walk NZ's coastline, tackles epic feats: skiing across Greenland, kayaking around Vancouver Island & cycling across the Australian Outback.

**Wuthering Heights (M) Drama/Romance 2hr 45min** Adaptation of the classic Emily Brontë story. Set against the Yorkshire moors, this tumultuous love story explores the intense & destructive relationship between Heathcliff & Catherine Earnshaw.
