





BING DAWE

b. 1952, New Zealand | Lives in Christchurch, New Zealand

Dawe has rightly been described as one of New Zealand's most prominent sculptors for his distinctive style of art which engages with pressing environmental issues in a way that inspires contemplation and open dialogue. Since graduating from the University of Cantebury's School of Fine Arts in the mid 1970s he has participated in numerous solo exhibitions including a major retrospective at the Robert McDougall Art Gallery in 1999. He is the recipient of many awards including the highly prestigious Wallace Art Award in the same year. His work can be found in significant public and private collections both in New Zealand and overseas, including public commissions in Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Rotorua.
