

Rules for Operating: Alert Level 2

At Alert Level 2 businesses can operate provided they can do so safely and can open to staff and customers if they meet public health requirements*. Businesses need to self-assess their ability to meet government restrictions and operate safely.

This list has been adapted from the <u>government covid-19</u> website. As the COVID-19 pandemic is an evolving situation please check the website for updated requirements.

Can you operate at Level 2?	
Reduce risk of transmission	 Businesses must reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission at work Close contact services can operate if they meet public health measures including robust record keeping, good hygiene practises and minimised contact
Can operate safely	 Comply with public health requirements including requirements for <u>engaging with customers</u> Meet all other health and safety obligations Implement alternative ways of working
Identify and manage risks	• Talk to staff to identify risks and ways to manage them
Stay home if sick	 Ask everyone including staff, contractors and customers with cold or flu-like symptoms to stay home
Keep groups of customers apart	 Groups of customers must be at least 1 metre apart, or 2 metres for retail businesses <u>Check out the physical distancing requirements for your business at Alert Level 2</u>
Keep contact tracing records	 Contact tracing records must be kept for anyone that will have a close interaction (not required for retail) Businesses must have an alternative system for customers not using the COVID Tracer App <u>Get your retailers contact tracing register</u> <u>Get your business (non-retail) contact tracing register</u>

* Different advice applies to essential healthcare workers, border agencies, courts / tribunal staff, first responders and corrections staff.



Display your QR code	 Businesses must display a NZ COVID Tracer QR code for each business location <u>Get your QR Code Poster</u>
Face coverings strongly encouraged	 Wearing a mask / face covering is encouraged if you are in close contact with others May be required for health & safety reasons in some workplaces
Reduce the number of shared surfaces	 Reduce the number of shared surfaces Regularly clean and disinfect surfaces
Wash your hands	 Wash your hands Good hygiene practices

Alert Level 2: Business Readiness Checklist

1. ARE YOUR PREMISES READY TO OPEN?

- □ Premises have been fully cleaned
- □ Cleaning products and PPE available
- □ NZ COVID Tracer QR code displayed
- □ Alternative contact tracing system in place
- Controlled entry set-up (e.g. for customers into retail store)

2. HAVE YOU GOT A COVID-19 MANAGEMENT PLAN?

- □ Contact tracing in place (including manual sign-in register)
- □ Cleaning and hygiene and measures (including PPE)
- □ Safe work practices
- Procedures to manage physical distancing requirements
- □ Emergency procedures

3. HOW WILL YOU ENSURE YOUR STAFF ARE KEPT SAFE AT WORK?

- High-risk staff (immune-compromised, respiratory issues) identified and managed
- □ Close physical contact limited or eliminated
- □ Increased hygiene and cleaning measures
- □ Appropriate PPE available and used correctly
- □ Sick workers told to stay home
- □ Contact tracing records maintained

4. HOW WILL YOU ENSURE YOUR CUSTOMERS ARE KEPT SAFE?

- □ Procedures to maintain physical distancing requirements
- □ Increased hygiene measures
- □ Masks or face-coverings encouraged
- □ Sick people told to stay home
- □ Contact tracing records maintained

5. HAVE YOU GOT A COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN?

- □ A safety plan outlines the COVID-19 related hazards and risk control measures for your business
